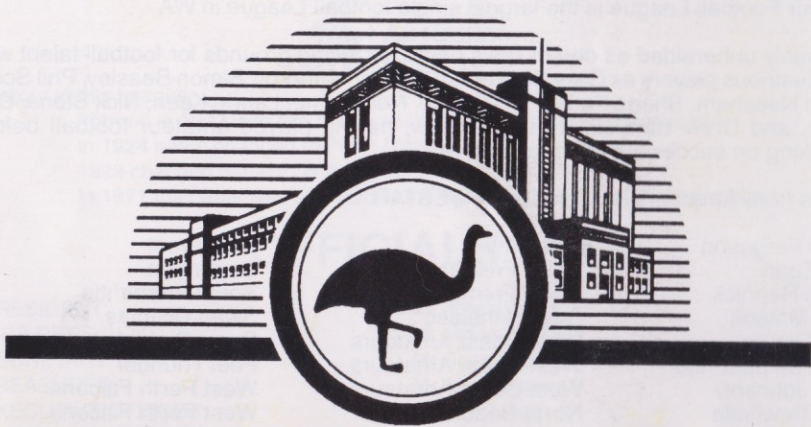

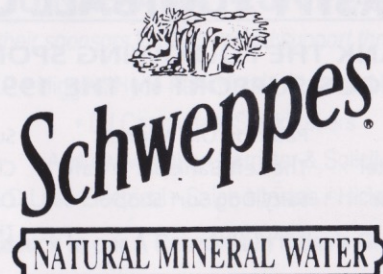

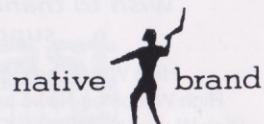

In 1997, The WAAFL will be in its 76th year of operation, having sustained its existence through the war years and the turmoil in the football industry during the 1980s.

The league has grown from a four team competition to the largest single organised football League in WA catering for over 7000 registered players between the ages of 18 years and 35 years, as well as considerably more volunteer personnel and social supporters.

The WAAFL is an important part of the metropolitan based community football with the stringent amateur standard set down by for players.

The WAAFL is a member of the Metropolitan Football Leagues Council (other members are Sunday F.L., Peel F.L., Superules and Women F.L.)

With 43 clubs, 140 teams and over 7000 registered players, The Western Australian Amateur Football League is the largest single football League in WA.

It is largely unheralded as one of WA's prime recruiting grounds for football talent with such illustrious players as Gary Buckenera, Peter Featherby, Simon Beasley, Phil Scott, Gerard Neesham, Shane Parker, Ian Dargie, Neil Balme, Laurie Keen, Nick Stone, Dan Parker, and Drew Banfield to name a few, having played amateur football before embarking on successful League careers.
