

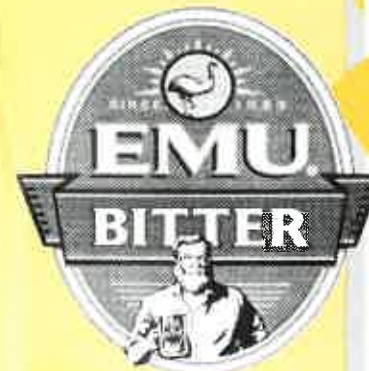

Congratulations to those individual players who won WAAFL Fairest and Best Awards in the various grades (several have now been successful on more than one occasion) and Goalkicking trophies.

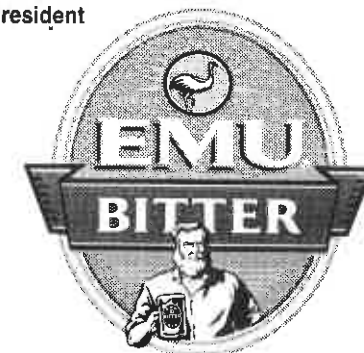
To both Trinity-Aquinas and Lynwood-Ferndale who were respective Champion Senior and Colts teams, their success on and off the field
