## DIRECTOR OF UMPIRES

It is with great pleasure that I present the umpiring report for 2002. I would firstly like to thank the umpiring coaching staff, the League office staff and especially the umpires for the season almost concluded.

Umpiring had some major changes this year, namely with the change of personnel in coaching the umpires and also the changes within the umpiring fraternity itself. With a number of retirements from the umpiring ranks, this left the umpiring stocks somewhat depleted. It was also disappointing that we had to revert back to the club umpiring system in a number of the grades due to lack of numbers and people to appoint these people. I suppose the jury is out as to whether the club umpiring system is the best system for football in the long term.

With the turmoil of the start of the season well and truly behind us, the umpiring fraternity has

developed a number of people that will continue the solid umpiring from this year to the future. We made changes that saw a total of eighteen umpires participate in A grade fixtures, seven of whom umpired A grade for the first time.

Overall the season has been very positive in the terms of umpiring quality, however I do strenuously request clubs to become more involved in promoting umpiring in a positive light. Clubs need to work hard in assisting the league and the football industry recognize umpiring as a major resource and assist in keeping our great game great.

To players, officials, spectators and umpires, I wish you all the very best for today's Grand Finals and have a fantastic day.

#### History of this League

- Formed in 1922 with five teams as the Mercantile Football Association.
- In 1924 name changed to Perth Districts Football Association.
- 1929 changed name to W.A. Amateur Football Association.
- In 1971 the name was changed to the W.A. Amateur Football League (Inc).

In 2001, the WAAFL will be in its 80th year of operation, having sustained its existence through the war years and the turmoil in the football industry during the 1980s.

With 47 clubs, 160 teams and over 7,000 registered players, the Western Australian Amateur Football League has grown from a four team competition to the largest single organised Football League in WA, catering for players from the age of 16 years, as well as considerable volunteer personnel and social

supporters.

The WAAFL is an important part of the metropolitan based community football with the stringent amateur standard set down for players.

The WAAFL is a member of the Metropolitan Football Leagues Council with other members including the Sunday Football League, Peel Football League, Super Rules and Women's Football League.
