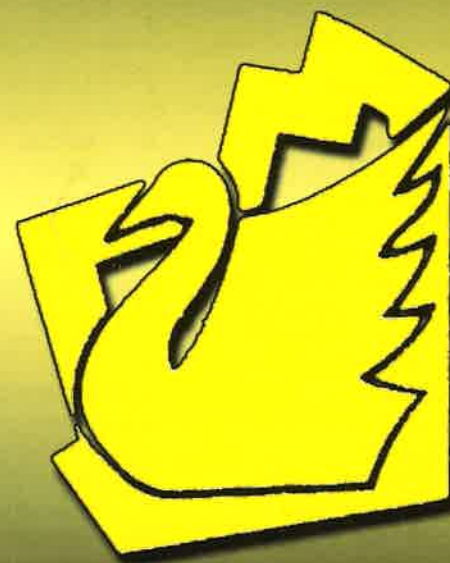

UMPIRES CO-ORDINATOR

Today represents the culmination of months of planning and preparation by participating clubs, their office bearers, coaches and players in qualifying to participate in a grand final and ultimately achieve the highest honour. Umpires, under the direction of their coaching staff, have also put in seven months of training and football matches to strive to achieve personal goals and ambitions and I am confident that the umpires selected are sufficiently prepared and focussed to acquit themselves well.

The past season has seen structural changes planned and implemented by the Western Australian Football Commission, which have already been of benefit to community football and in particular umpiring at this level. Umpire development has been the theme for the year with many young umpires officiating in WAAFL 'colts' fixtures under the guidance of a selected 'mentor' senior umpire. This has been only possible through the tremendous cooperation of the junior umpire coaches and their umpires and parents. The exposure to senior football has been of great benefit to most junior umpires and the fast tracking of a significant number of them.

Another significant development strategy has been the policy for excess WAFL umpires to officiate in A, A reserve and B grade games as allocated by the coaching staff. This has enabled us to run promising young umpires with more

experienced WAAFL panel umpires. It is envisaged that this practice will be expanded for future seasons as WAFL panel numbers are increased which will be of particular benefit to community football.

The school's boundary umpire program operated once again throughout the season with some seventy youngsters being introduced to football officiating. There is a growing number of schools wishing to participate in the program which is indicative of the benefits to the personal development of those who participate.

The coaching staff this year comprised Peter Repper (field umpires' coach), Paul Smith (field umpire assistant coach and boundary umpires' coach) and Terry Kenny (goal umpires' coach). Seamus Rafferty and Byron Hadjimihalakis assisted with observing and selection duties. Peter Repper's central umpire philosophies have been embraced by the panel with particular emphasis being on 'player management'. This experienced group has had a marked effect on the standard of umpiring throughout the season and their time and expertise has been greatly appreciated.

Finally, on behalf of the umpiring fraternity, good luck to all participants in today's grand finals.

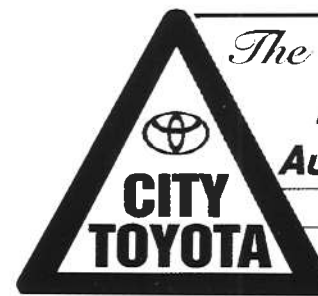

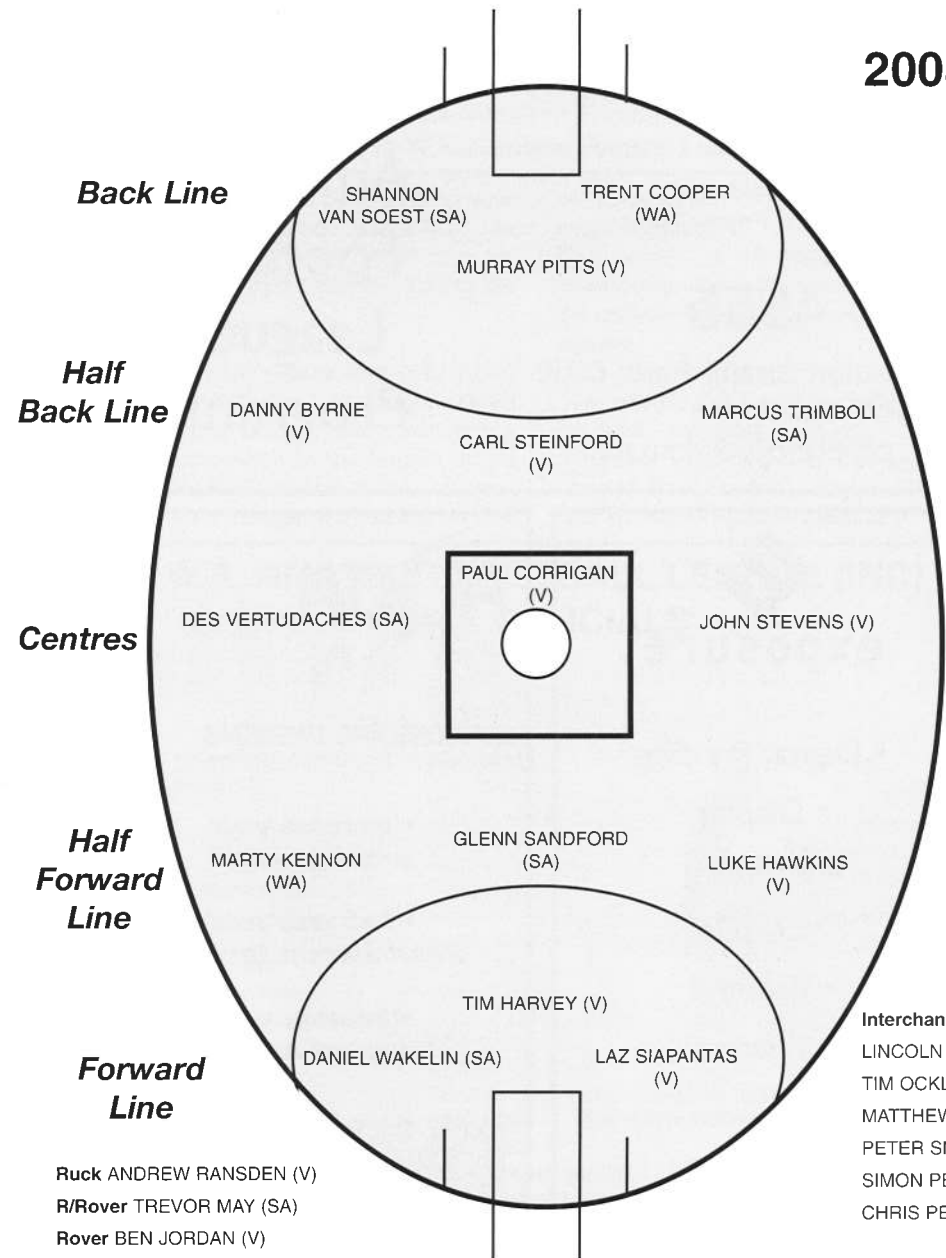

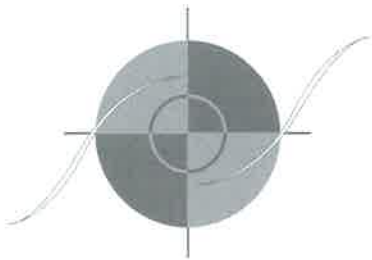

History of this League

- Formed in 1922 with five teams as the Mercantile Football Association
- 1924 - name changed to the Perth Districts Football Association
- 1929 – name changed to W.A. Amateur Football Association
- 1971 – name changed to W.A. Amateur Football League (Inc.)

In 2003, the WAAFL will be in its 81st year of operation, having sustained its experience through the war years and the turmoil in the football industry during the 1980's.

With 43 clubs, 147 teams and over 7,000 registered players, the Western Australian Amateur Football League has grown from a five team competition to the largest single organised Football League in WA, catering for players from the age of 16 years, as well

as considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

The WAAFL is an important part of the metropolitan based community football with the stringent amateur standard set down for players.

The WAAFL is a member of the Community Football Leagues Council with other members including the Sunday Football League, Peel Football League, Super Rules and Women's Football League.
