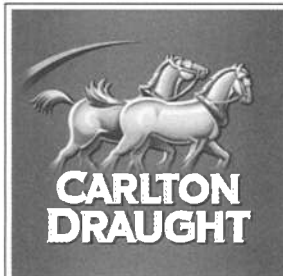

WAAFL STATE REPRESENTATIVE REPORT – 2004



This years representative program saw the introduction of a modified selection criteria where players under 23 years of age only could be eligible to represent our competition.

The initiative has been vigorously backed by the WAAFL executive committee for a number of years in the belief that not only would it make for a more even competition with the Victorian and South Australian Amateur leagues but given the focus on young up and coming players it would better illustrate the worth of the Amateur competitions in contrast to the AFL and relevant State Leagues.

Given this new concept excluded virtually all the regular representative players we have had in recent years we needed to start from scratch in respect to the selection process.

After a meeting with A,B,C & D grade club Coaches and Presidents to explain the new criteria player nominations were called for. In excess of 100 players were invited to participate in the 10 week training program. Their ultimate aim to achieve selection in the State Under 23 WAAFL side to travel to Melbourne to play the highly rated Victorians in June.

The players were required to train in South Perth every Tuesday night followed up by a Sunday morning rehabilitation session at Challenge Stadium.

Certainly talent dictated selection as it does with any representative side but a huge emphasis was also placed on commitment to the program and match day club performances and I'm happy to say that every player that was eventually selected thoroughly deserved their spot.

Besides the numerous training sessions there was an internal practice match along with night games against the Sunday League competition under 23 year squad as well as the WA State Country open age squad who were gearing up to compete in their own National Carnival to be held in Bunbury later in the year.

Both night games were keenly contested affairs in excellent conditions with the State Amateur side winning both. This intense lead up ensured we travelled to Melbourne fully prepared with our best available side, confident of a good showing against the Vics.

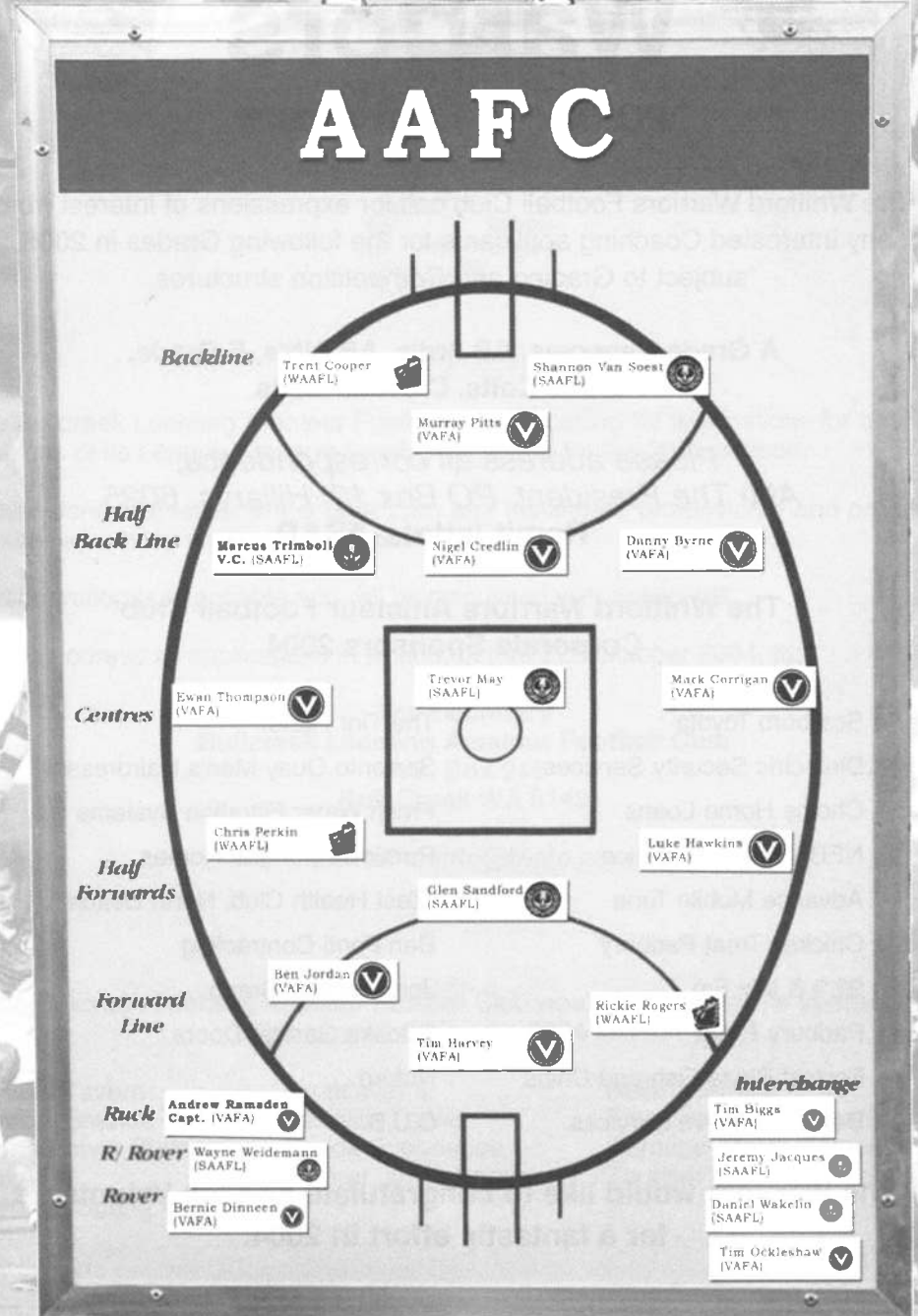

History of this League

- Formed in 1922 with five teams as the Mercantile Football Association
- 1924 - name changed to the Perth Districts Football Association
- 1929 – name changed to W.A. Amateur Football Association
- 1971 – name changed to W.A. Amateur Football League (Inc.)

In 2004, the W.A.A.F.L. will be in its 82nd year of operation, having sustained its experience through the war years and the turmoil in the football industry during the 1980's.

The W.A.A.F.L. is an important part of the metropolitan based community football with the stringent amateur standard set down for players.

With 44 clubs, 143 teams including 4 in the W.A.F.A. and over 9,000 registered players, the Western Australian Amateur Football League has grown from a four team competition to the largest single organised Football League in WA, catering for players from the age of 16 years, as well as considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

The W.A.A.F.L. is a member of the Community Football Leagues Council with other members including the Sunday Football League, Peel Football League, Super Rules and Women's Football League.
