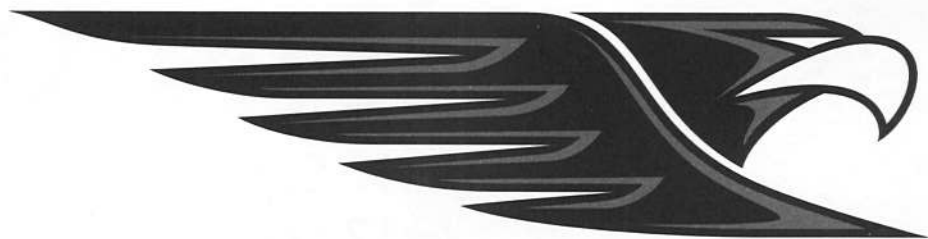

## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The WAAFL now in its 84th year is concluding another successful season of Community football where we continue to provide an outlet for people to administer, play, officiate, sponsor or support our unique and great Australian game across the metropolitan area.

All 28 participating teams in the Grand Finals represent 24 different Clubs. They have risen above the rest and should provide a great spectacle and show piece for our League.

Whilst Players, Coaches & Support staff and Umpires strive hard to be the best on Grand Final day we must remember and pay tribute to all Clubs who make up the League and work tirelessly all year within their districts and committees in organizing teams. Club committees are made up of all volunteers, with a majority also playing the game and working long hours after training and matches to assist in fundraising, social events and attracting sponsorships to meet their commitments to the WAAFL and other associated costs in the conduct of their Club.

On average it costs each club \$436.00 per player they put on the field. Affiliation fees to the WAAFL, which includes the cost of footballs, Council ground hire, Liability & Player insurance, administration etc are raised by those dedicated volunteers. By way of example currently in 'A' Grade the average total affiliation fee is \$25,050.00, B Grade \$20,403.00, C Grade \$16,500.00 & D Grade \$7889.00. A Colts team which is the life blood of the future for Clubs costs on average \$3,690.00.

The Board of Management has not increased fees to the Clubs in the past 3 seasons thanks to the increased sponsorships/partnership from various Companies but in particular the support of Fosters Australia and the West Coast Eagles.

Sponsors Metisc, Park Auto Centre, Burley Sekem, Cougar Sportswear, Elastoplast, Quill Stationery, Mouse Promotions and next year Autoparts all contributed and helped in our quest

to maintain and where possible lower overall fees. The Sponsors financial support and provision of product has greatly benefited all Clubs and in conjunction with additional funding via the WAFC this year enabled the Board to decrease Colts fees by 20% which equated to approximately \$18,500.00. The WA Football Commission has also greatly assisted with administration costs and resources with the appointment of Community Football Umpires Coordinator Tim Priest and Club Development & Volunteer Coordinator Warren Nel.

One of the greatest on going costs to Community Football clubs is the charge for the use of playing reserves through the user pay system. The majority of players and officials of every club already contribute to the costs of the provision and maintenance of these grounds via rates paid either as a home owner, business proprietor or living with parents or rented properties. This cost is an area that is being closely examined by the WAAFL Board in conjunction with the WAFC to see what concessions maybe able to be gained from both State and Local Governments.

The members of WAAFL Executive, Ron Webster & all Staff are to be congratulated for their efforts to serve the clubs, provide a professional and organized competition for all levels of ability. Their work has improved the image of the league both within and outside the football circle.

Congratulations to all the Fairest & Best winners in all grades, the leading goal kickers in A & B grade, the U/23 State players, Coaches & Staff and the 8 All Australian U/23 Amateur players who will soon be heading off to Ireland to play international rules.

Enjoy Grand Final Day, best of luck to your team. Hope to see you back in 2006.

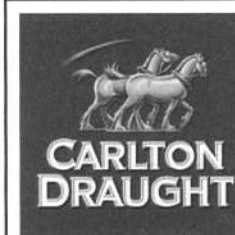

# WAAFL STATE REPRESENTATIVE REPORT – 2005



This year's state program saw the continuation of the modified selection criteria where players under 23 years of age only could be eligible to represent our competition. The concept has been vigorously backed by the WAAFL executive committee in the belief that it would make for a more even competition between the three competing States, ensuring the focus was on young, up and coming players, which would better illustrate the worth of the Amateur grass roots competitions in contrast to the AFL and relevant State Leagues.

This year Both Victoria & South Australia committed to the new formula enabling all States to play under the same selection criteria. Although the foundation of this year's squad was made up of players who were still eligible from the 2004 side, over 60 invited players attended the eight week lead up training program.

Certainly talent dictated selection as it does with any representative side but a huge emphasis was also placed on commitment to the program and match day club performances. Besides the numerous training sessions there were night games against the WA State Country open age squad & the Sunday League competition under

23 year squad. Both night games were keenly contested affairs with the State Amateur side recording narrow wins.

This lead to our first clash against the South Australian under 23 Amateur side which was played as a curtain raiser to the West Coast Eagles vs St Kilda match at Subiaco Oval. In excellent conditions, having narrowly led for most of the day, WA kicked away in the last quarter to record an impressive 23 point win. This win was the first for a WA Amateur State Side in 14 years and was just reward for the efforts of both players and administrators in embracing the under 23's concept.

Two weeks later the final squad of 25 players spent a weekend away at Em Halliday Camp in Hillarys where they engaged in team building exercises and planned their attack on the Victorians who they were playing the following week.

The game against Victoria was played at Leederville Oval in atrocious conditions and with WA drawing level just prior to half time the Vics were very concerned their mantle as the best Amateur football state was under threat. WA were four goals down at 3/4 time and although

the players were exhausted they were able to keep the Vics scoreless in the final quarter and in the end just fell short of a courageous historical victory. Given the conditions it was an excellent standard game, played in the right spirit by two very determined sides.

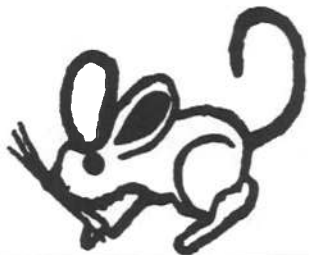
competition and hopefully it will inspire more players from more clubs to try out for future State squads.

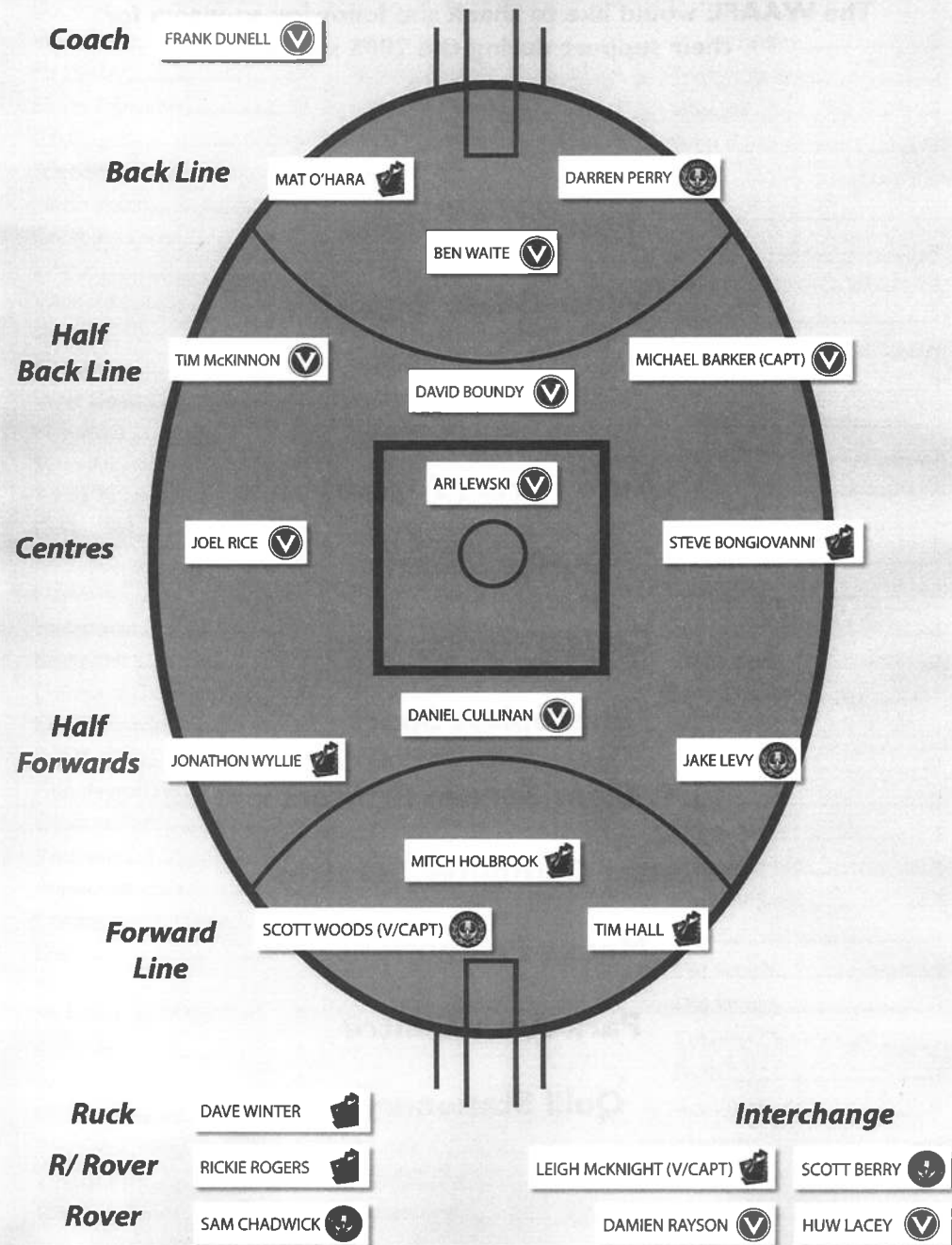

### WAAFL 1922 – 2005

#### History of this League

- ▶ Formed in 1922 with five teams as the Mercantile Football Association
- ▶ 1924 – name changed to the Perth Districts Football Association
- ▶ 1929 – name changed to W.A. Amateur Football Association
- ▶ 1971 – name changed to W.A. Amateur Football League (Inc.)

In 2005, the WAAFL will be in its 84th year of operation, having sustained its experience through the war years and the turmoil in the football industry during the 1980's.

With 40 clubs, 145 teams and over 8,500 registered players, the Western Australian Amateur Football League has grown from a four team competition to the largest single organised Football League in WA, catering for players from the age of 16 years, as well as considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

The WAAFL is an important part of the metropolitan based community football with the stringent amateur standard set down for players.

The WAAFL is a member of the Community Football Council with other members including the Sunday Football League, Peel Football League, WAFA, Super Rules and Women's Football League.
