The development of the senior community umpiring group has been significant on a number of fronts during this year.

I was delighted to secure Hamer Park and the associated building facility for the training and coaching development of the umpires. This arrangement has a security of tenure in that a Memorandum of Understanding has been agreed amongst the key parties for three seasons. # WAAFL STATE UNDER 23 2006



This year's state program saw the continuation of the modified selection criteria where only players 23 years of age and under are eligible to represent our competition.

Although this was the third year WA has selected sides under this criteria it was officially the second year of the triennial round robin State competition between the three major Amateur football states in Victoria, South Australia and West Australia. With the dominant Victorians playing host to the other two states in 2006 we commenced training the week after Easter in full knowledge of the daunting challenge facing us.

Once again the foundation of this year's squad was made up of players who were still eligible from the 2005 and in some cases the 2004 sides yet over 80 invited players attended the seven week Wednesday nights lead up training program.

As it does with any representative side a huge emphasis was placed on talent along with commitment to the program and match day club performances. Prospective players were being monitored by a team of dedicated selectors along with their respective club coaches who offered essentially required quality feedback.

Besides the numerous training sessions there were the annual night games against the WA Country Football League open age squad and the Sunday Football League under 23 year squad where a narrow loss to the country and a narrow win against the Sunday league were recorded. Both lead up games were very important in our preparation and selection strategies to take on formidable Victorians who in 85 years of interstate games had never been beaten by WA at home.

In contrast to previous years we deliberately selected a very big and physically strong side to take to Melbourne and we were fortunate a number of mature bodied players were still eligible to play for us this year. The reason for this selection strategy was because we felt the smaller, heavier Victorian ground didn't suit the

typical WA Amateurs open playing style and as such we needed to take in specific player types capable of playing a physically aggressive and super disciplined game plan. As it turned out there were 12 boys making their representative debuts.

The game itself was a beauty and although we were getting our fair share of the ball, at the fifteen minute mark of the first quarter we found ourselves 5 goals to 1 down and were looking down the barrel of another potential pasting against the seemingly invincible Victorians.

Then all of a sudden the players, who were working very hard to the letter of our game plan and player strengths, kicked two late goals and the feeling at quarter time was that we were in with a chance.

The second quarter saw us dominate the clearances at stoppages and by maintaining the physical approach to the ball and a direct style of play to our tall forwards we had the Vics on the back foot kicking 5 goals to 1 to take a handy 2 goal lead in at half time.

The third quarter saw some wonderful team and individual efforts and although we were leading by 6 goals at three quarter time you can never discount the fighting spirit of any Victorian side and we knew we were in for one hell of a last quarter.

The final quarter was a goal for goal affair and with the WA boys never allowing the Vics the opportunity to get their renowned running game into gear, the WAAFL eventually ran out very worthy 6 goal winners.

When the siren sounded the feeling was like winning a grand final, and in some ways even better given the historical significance, and did the players celebrate!

On top of this I've never seen bigger and more satisfied smiles than what our WAAFL executive and committee wore post game and it was a testament to their courage and convictions that the under 23 interstate concept didn't fall over at the first hurdle when we copped a thrashing in the 2003 inaugural year. Big Ronny Webster would have been looking down on us with the biggest grin of all and should we be successful against South

In closing special mention must go to all the players, coaches and their WAAFL clubs as without their input and support, State Representative Amateur football wouldn't be as alive, vibrant, and now we can add successful, as it is today.

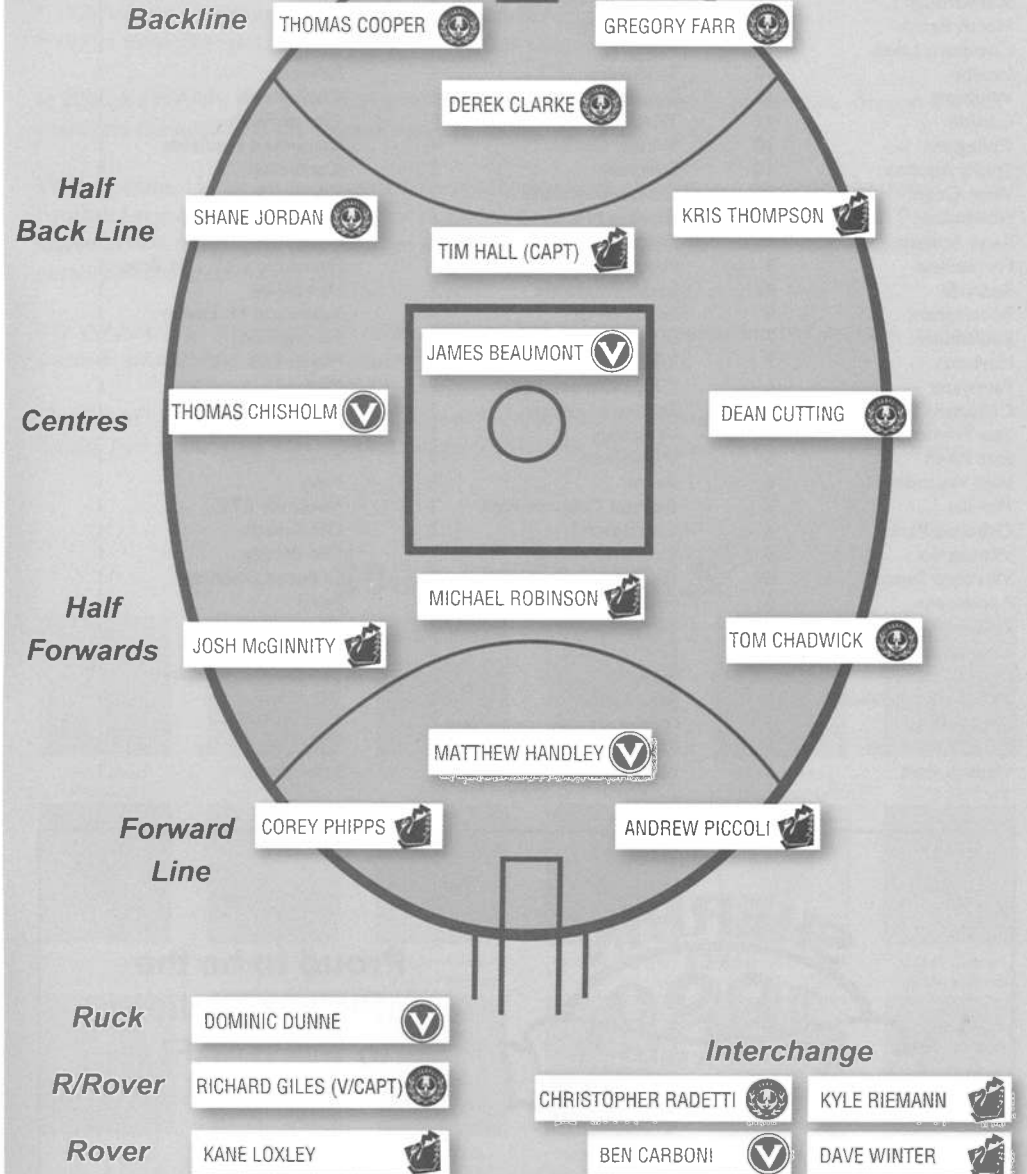

In 2006 the WAAFL is in its 85th year of operation, having sustained its experience through the war years and the turmoil in the football industry during the 1980's.

With 42 clubs, 150 teams and over 9 500 registered players, the Western Australian Amateur Football League has grown from a four team competition to the largest single organised Football league in WA, catering for players from the age of 16 years, as well as considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

The WAAFL is an important part of the metropolitan based community football with the stringent amateur standard set down for players.

The WAAFL is a member of the Community Football Council with other members including the Sunday Football League, Peel Football League, Wafa, WA Masters and Women's Football League.
